# Storage FAQ

## **Timeframe**

November – March (5 months)

## **Move-in Dates**

The official move-in day for storage is Saturday, October 28th but we encourage you to come earlier in the week.

Additional move-in days are:

Monday, the 23rd: 9 - 3

Tuesday, the 24th: 9 - noon

Wednesday, the 25th: 9 - 3

Thursday, the 26th: 9 - noon

Friday, the 27th: 9 - noon

Saturday, the 28th: 8 - noon

Units cannot be dropped off after hours. If the unit is dropped off after hours, it will not be moved into storage until payment is made.

Units can be brought in following the 28th, but an indoor storage location is not guaranteed and will still be charged the full 5 months.

## **Move out Date**

Units will begin to be removed from buildings starting the week of March 25th. Units will be pulled out of buildings and parked in the front parking lot and in front of buildings. The fairgrounds gates will be locked at night.

You do not need to schedule an appointment to pick up your unmotorized unit (boats, campers, unmotorized vehicles). Find it, hook up, head home.

Appointments will need to be made to pull out RVs, 5th wheels and cars. If you need to charge a battery, this must be done the week of March 25th.

All units MUST be removed from the fairgrounds NO LATER than April 1, 2024 or the vehicle will be towed from the property at the owner's expense. The solar eclipse is Monday, April 8th and we must ensure that we have enough time to ready the fairgrounds prior to building rentals beginning on Wednesday, April 3rd. NO EXCEPTIONS.



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## Cost

\$2 per linear foot per month  
\$15 one-time fee for handling

## How do I measure?

Total length is taken from the very back of the stored unit to the very front, which includes tongue or hitch.

## Does the fair board measure?

Yes, we will measure the unit before it is stored to ensure the correct length. You will receive a yellow tag to be placed on the unit to confirm it was measured and paid for prior to the unit being placed in to a building.

## Payment

Payment is due is full upfront for all 5 months  
Cash, check, debit (no additional fee), or credit (additional 3.5% fee)

Beat the line!

If you provide a card number on your application, we will charge the card at a later date to expedite the check-in process.

## How do I guarantee I have a spot?

We encourage you to fill out the Jotforms paperwork prior to arrival to expedite the process. There is no guarantee your unit will be placed inside a building. Storage is first come first serve. If indoor space runs out, the unit will be placed in the Buckeye Building (cattle barn). The Buckeye Building is an open air facility with a roof. Placement in the Buckeye Building is not discounted.

## What do I need to provide?

Payment in full  
Insurance- hard copy or email to [debbie.clunen@hancockfairgrounds.org](mailto:debbie.clunen@hancockfairgrounds.org)  
Signed paperwork  
Optional- Keys for vehicles. We will store your keys if you would like us to.

## Is there a form I fill out?

Yes, please visit our website or Facebook page for the Jotforms link. 2022-2023 storage customers will all be sent an email that was provided to us last year.



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## **I've never stored a unit with you before- what do I do?**

We try to make the process as smooth as possible! Schedule an appointment earlier in the week (week of October 23rd) during our open business hours. Pull the unit up in front of the North Grandstands (unmotorized units) and park it. A staff member will measure the unit to verify length. We will then collect your signed application, insurance, and payment. You will be given a yellow tag that confirms payment and this yellow tag will be placed on the front tongue/ bumper/ hitch for staff use.

If you have a motorized vehicle, RV or fifth wheel, you will need to park the unit yourself in designated barns. We will keep your keys in the office if you would like us to.

## **What do I do with my car battery or propane tank?**

Batteries and propane tanks must be removed. If the propane tank cannot be removed because it is integrated in to the unit, it needs to be emptied.

## **I want to pull out before the end of March**

If you would like to pull your unit out of storage prior to the end of March, special arrangements will need to be made. We encourage you to come in as early as possible during move-in to ensure we can park your unit near an exit door in a building. If you do not make these arrangements, we cannot guarantee we can get your unit out early.

## **Damages**

The Hancock County Agricultural Society is liable for damages or theft. Units stored inside of buildings will remain locked throughout the storage duration. In the case of damage or theft, we encourage you to file an incident report with the Sheriff's Office.
