Open Class Pee Wee Showmanship General Rules:

- 1. Open to anyone too young to participate in Jr. Fair showmanship.
- 2. Participants need not be an Open Show Exhibitor. Please contact Barn Superintendent if an animal is needed for exhibition.

Dairy Cattle

General Rules:

- 1. All animals regardless of age must be registered and owned by the exhibitor.
- 2. Please refer to Health Rule 901:1-18-06 Ohio Department of Agriculture.
- 3. Exhibitors must be ready to show when called by the Superintendent please refer to posted class numbers prior to show.
- 4. Animals must show in individual classes to be eligible for groups.
- 5. For all exhibitors originating within Hancock County All heifers must be in place Monday night before the start of the Fair; All cows must be in place by 8 a.m. Tuesday. Lactating cows will be permitted to go home immediately following the show. Heifers must remain at the fair until the conclusion of the fair and released by the Director in Charge.

6. For all exhibitors originating outside of Hancock County – Please coordinate your arrival and departure times with the superintendent. Space will be assigned on a first come first serve basis.
