Sportsmanship Contract

A Parent/Guardian and Jr. Fair Exhibitor agree and understand it is their personal responsibility to adhere to the following sportsmanship policy when entering an exhibit in the Poultry Department:

Verbal abuse, physical abuse or harassment towards directors, judges, ring stewards, superintendents, employees, OSU Extension Staff, Junior Fair members, club advisors or volunteers of the Hancock County Fair will not be tolerated. You may be escorted from the Junior Fair event, premiums forfeited and upon Hancock County Agricultural Society committee decisions, the family members may not be able to exhibit at the Hancock County Fair for a period indicated by the committee based on the severity of the situation.

PRIOR TO FAIR

- 1. Per the Ohio Department of Agriculture, a valid health certificate is **REQUIRED** for each chicken, turkey, guinea, and pheasant to be exhibited. See **Rule 901:1-18-05** below.
- 2. If the bird is less than 1 year old, the hatchery invoice with the NPIP participant stamp/information serves as the health certificate.
- 3. If a chicken is greater than 1 year old, each bird must be Pullorum tested by a certified Pullorum tester within 90 days before the first day of the fair. Contact the **Blanchard Valley Poultry Association** or a Poultry Superintendent for scheduled Pullorum testing events or Pullorum tester contact information.

- 4. If a turkey is greater than 1 year old, each turkey must be NPIP tested by a certified NPIP tester within a year of the first day of the fair. Contact the **Blanchard Valley Poultry Association** or a Poultry Superintendent for NPIP tester information.
- 5. A copy of the required health certificates must be submitted to the Senior Fair Office by the last day of open class entries. Entries will be **voided**, and birds cannot be caged if required health certificates are not received by the deadline.
- 6. Submitted health certificates are **REQUIRED** to display purchase location, purchase date and NPIP participant stamp/information.

Per Health Regulations from the State of Ohio Department of Agriculture – Rule 901:1-18-05, each poultry exhibitor must comply with one of the following:

- A. All turkeys, chickens and gamebirds moved within or imported into Ohio for exhibition must either:
- (1) Originate directly from a flock or hatchery which is a participant in the national poultry improvement plan for the eradication of disease and be accompanied by documentary evidence that they meet the requirement of this paragraph;
- (2) Originate directly from a flock which has had a negative test for pullorum/fowl typhoid disease within twelve months preceding the opening date of exhibition and be accompanied by documentary evidence that they meet the requirement of this paragraph;
- (3) Have had a negative test for pullorum/fowl typhoid disease, within ninety days, preceding the opening date of the exhibition and be accompanied by documentary evidence that they meet the requirement of this paragraph;

The rapid whole blood test shall not be used to test turkeys for compliance with the requirements of paragraphs (A)(2), (A)(3) and (A)(4) of this rule.

Waterfowl, doves and pigeons are exempt from this rule.

GENERAL RULES

- 1. Competition open to residents of Ohio and USA.
- 2. Judging will be based on recognized American Poultry Association and American Bantam Association Standards of Perfection and comparison method.
- 3. First, Second and Third Place ribbons awarded for each class.
- 4. For premium payout and distribution see Hancock County Agricultural Specific rules.
- 5. All entries are required to be in place before 8:00 PM on Monday before the fair.

- 6. All exhibitors must check-in before entering the barn with their birds. Violation of this rule will result in entries being **voided** and all poultry exhibits being removed from the premises.
- Birds/Blown Eggs CANNOT be removed prior to release date and dismissal time without approval of the Barn Superintendent, Barn Director, and Veterinarian. Contact the Barn Superintendent or Barn Director to obtain approval and the proper release form.

FOWL RULES

1.For Non-Standard Large Fowl Breeds and Non-Standard Bantam Breed Classes, only one (1) entry per person per class/age definition. No entry limits for other fowl classes/age definitions.

- 2. One (1) bird per entry and per cage.
- 3. Entries must be made by Division Name, Class Number/Name of Variety and Age Definition.
- 4.Age Definition: **Old** = hatched prior to Sept 1st of previous year, **Young** = hatched after Sept 1st of previous year.
 - 5. The Poultry Barn will be open for bird check-in on Monday prior to the fair from 9:00 AM until 8:00 PM.
- 6.No sorting, swapping or substitution of birds will be allowed once checked-in at the Fair. Once a bird is checked-in, the bird CANNOT be replaced with a different bird.

7.Super Champion and Reserve Super Champion awards are selected from all fowl divisions. Super Champion award is \$10.00 premium and trophy. Reserve Super Champion award is \$5.00 premium and trophy. Both trophies donated by **Lacy (Allen) Gladish**.

- 8. For all fowl divisions, a Best of Division winner will be selected and awarded a \$5 premium. Premium is donated by the **Blanchard Valley Poultry Association**.
- 9. Best of Breed ribbons awarded only if four (4) or more birds are exhibited within the breed.
- 10. Free food. Food donated by Omni Feed and Supply, LLC.
- 11. Free cooping. Wood shavings donated by Legacy Farmers Cooperative.
- 12. The best of care will be provided.
- 13. All birds are entered at owner's risk.
- 14. Securing cage doors with a locking device is prohibited. Barn Superintendent and/or Barn Director reserve the right to cut locking devices from cages. Zip-ties are recommended to secure cage doors.
- 15. No decorations, ribbons, name identification displayed on or near a cage until judging is complete for all divisions.
- 16. Personal supplies are **REQUIRED** to be stored in barn/tent beneath cage supports or within personal vehicle. Supplies cannot be in aisleways (fully or partially), next to cages or outside of barn/tent.

EGG RULE

- 1.Only two (2) entries per person per class.
- 2. Three (3) eggs per entry.
- 3.NO store-bought eggs permitted.
- 4. Entries must be made by Division Name, Class Number and Color Definition.
- 5. Mottled or Speckled eggs are to be entered in the appropriate class with an 'Other' color definition.
- 6.The breed producing the eggs should be noted in entry description.
- 7. The Grange Building will be open for egg check-in on Monday prior to the fair from 9:00 AM until 8:00 PM.
- 8. Judging elements will include color, shape, size, shell texture, uniformity, freshness, appearance.
- 9. Entry will be displayed as specified by Barn Superintendent.
- 10. Eggs WILL NOT be released to exhibitor once checked-in. They will be disposed of by either the Barn Director or a Barn Superintendent.

DECORATED EGG RULES

- 1. Only one (1) entry per person per class.
- 2. Class is determined by exhibitor's age on January 1st of the current year.
- 3. Entries must be made by Division Name and Class Number.
- 4. Entry must have been created by the exhibitor.
- 5. The Grange Building will be open for decorated egg check-in on Monday prior to the fair from 9:00 AM until 8:00 PM.
- 6. Entry can be no larger than 12" x 12" x 12". Larger entries will be disqualified.
- 7. Entry may contain more than one (1) egg.
- 8. Any size eggs may be used.
- 9. Eggs must be blown or fresh.
- 10. The outline of the egg must be maintained, and the shape must be recognizable.
- 11. Eggs can be painted, adorned with beads, colored paper, shells, and other materials.
- 12. Cannot use materials that will spoil, rot or mold during the exhibit.
- 13. Judging elements will include artistic effect, originality, quality of construction, use of color and use of materials.
- 14. Fresh eggs WILL NOT be released to the exhibitor once checked in. They will be disposed of by either the Barn Director or a Barn Superintendent.
