All tickets for the Hancock County Fair are on sale NOW! Tickets will be sold primarily online. Ticket bearers will be able to print their tickets at home and carry them to the gate or present their tickets digitally on their phones or tablets at the fair and/or event admission gates.

We encourage you to purchase your tickets online prior to arriving at the fair. All gates will scan electronic tickets. Cash purchases will be limited to select gates.

ALL TICKETS AND DAILY ADMISSION INCLUDES PARKING

ADULT MEMBERSHIP CERTIFICATE

\$2.00 per adult with purchase of a \$30 Season Ticket – Available through **August 22, 2024** at 5:00 p.m. in the Senior Fair Office. Entitles the member to vote at the annual election of Directors, according to the rules of the Society. Membership Certificates are available to Hancock County RESIDENTS ONLY, who are 18 years old. Certificates must be picked up no later than 10 minutes prior to the start of the Election on Labor Day.

ADULT SEASON TICKET

\$30.00 per adult (18 and over) plus processing fees – Available January 1, online and at the Fair Office through August 26, 2024. After August 26, Season Tickets are available Online Only. Admits one (1) adult and dependent members of their family 9 years of age and younger.

YOUTH SEASON TICKET (tickets available online)

\$15.00 per youth – Available through August 26, 2024 at 8:00 p.m. Admits one (1) youth age 10-17 and dependent members of their family 9 years of age and younger.

DAILY SINGLE ADMISSION (tickets available online)

\$10.00 per adult – Admits one (1) adult and dependent members of their family 9 years of age and younger.

EVERYDAY \$5.00 per Senior (65+)

EVERYDAY \$5.00 per Youth (10-17)

ALL TICKETS AND DAILY ADMISSION INCLUDES PARKING

All vehicles shall park in an angular manner in the marked parking areas.

All vehicles shall leave by the marked exits.

Midway and livestock areas will be closed to all traffic except emergency vehicles between 10:00 a.m. and 11:00 p.m. daily.

Golf Carts require a permit. Permits and rules may be obtained at the Senior Fair Office. Proof of insurance is required.

A parking and camping area will be provided for concessionaires and personnel.

RESERVED PARKING is available in the Sandusky St. Parking Lot. Cost is \$100 per parking spot. Spot holder must obtain a Season Ticket.

Parking for fair officials will be reserved near the office.

Emergency vehicles will park in their designated areas.

Riding of bicycles, motorcycles, motor scooters, horses and ponies will not be allowed on the fairgrounds three (3) days prior to the fair or during the fair. (Exhibits not included.)

Fire lanes are provided for the protection of all buildings. Please cooperate and keep these free of cars, trucks, other vehicles, equipment, hay, straw, and manure.

All livestock trailers and trucks must park in designated areas. Vehicles found in "No Parking" areas will be towed at owner's expense. The Hancock County Agricultural Society assumes no responsibility for damage to or loss of parked vehicles or personal property contained within parked vehicles.
