The members shall be selected by submitting a completed Junior Fair Department Royalty Application form. Each applicant must be a member of Hancock County 4-H or FFA.

# Section 2.

Candidates must have completed a minimum of one year participation in the specie specific to this application.

# Section 3.

Queen & King Candidates must be 14 to 18 years old as of January 1, of the current year to be eligible.

Princess & Prince Candidates must be 9 to 13 years old as of January 1, of the current year to be eligible.

#### Section 4

Queen & King Candidates may serve a maximum of 2 one-year terms (2 years total). Princess & Prince Candidates may serve a maximum of 2 one-year terms (2 years total). Must re apply and interview each year.

# Section 5.

Department Royalty Candidates must have participated in the current year's Hancock County 4-H Livestock Interview or the Hancock County 4-H Make Up Livestock Interview.

#### Section 6.

If crowned, you must attend the following

#### events:

- Opening Fair Ceremonies
- Jr. Fair Night
- Any other livestock specific event throughout the year
- Help award ribbons and trophies at the fair for the Horse Department.
- Be in attendance during the fair to represent the 4-H Horse Department.
- Help obtain sale items for the 4-H Horse Department Auction held Monday at the fair and be present to help with the auction.
- The Queen, or other royalty, may be asked to carry the flag at the beginning of a major fair event. Selected royalty will be notified well in advance of the event time and place.
- Royalty are expected to wear proper attire especially when wearing their crowns and sashes. The 4-H Horse Department requests that Royalty try to wear their crown, hats and sashes as much as possible.

### Section 7.

Royalty is expected to be at all horse shows during the week of the fair to assist with but not limited to:

Handing out ribbons/ Trophies

Carrying the Flag at an opening ceremony

Assisting with gate

#### Section 8.

Royalty will be judged on a points system. Points will be awarded from the Royalty interviews as well as the Highest score taken from Royalty Showmanship during the June 14, July 12 & August 9 Horse Fun show. Recommend to participate in all royalty showmanship shows opportunities.
